We expect all employees and contractors to be leaders in workplace health and safety through the identification of hazards, the effective control of high potential risk, working in compliance with Teck’s safe work practices and procedures, and maintaining compliance with applicable occupational health and safety law and policy. We also expect supervisors to ensure the health and safety of all workers under their direct supervision.

We all share in the responsibility for our safety and that of our co-workers. Working together we can eliminate deaths, serious injuries, and diseases in the workplace; we will accept nothing less.
